MINUTES OF THE ANNUAL PARISH MEETING OF WEST DOWN PARISH COUNCIL HELD AT WEST DOWN PARISH HALL ON 3rd MAY 2017

The Chairman opened the meeting at 7.00pm by welcoming the members of the public present.

- 1. <u>Apologies</u>. Apologies were received from CCIIr A Davis and DCIIr P Barker, PCSO P Grantham and CIIr R Watts.
- 2. <u>Minutes of the last Meeting</u>. The Chair summarised the previously approved Minutes of the last APM held on 4th May 2016.
- 3. Questions from the Public. The Chair invited questions from the Public.
 - a. Mr D Ayre spoke on a number of subjects:
 - (1) In previous years he has complained about the condition of the 'main drag' road from The Square to The Triangle, which has now recently been resurfaced, for which he gave thanks.
 - (2) Following on from the resurfacing of the road, white lining of junctions and signs by the school have now taken place but he was disappointed that the white lines outside Quicks Tenement had not been re-instated.
 - (3) There are still cases of fly-tipping occurring, especially in the area by Crackaway Barton.
